Rules and Regulations

The following Rules and Regulations are to enable the club members the greatest enjoyment from the club's facility. It is expected that all members and their guests observe these rules and regulations at all times.

Club Membership

Members are entitled to the use of the club's facilities. A Single membership includes one person, Couples membership includes member and spouse or significant other, Family membership includes member and spouse or significant other and children under 18 years of age or children less than 25 years of age attending college living at home.

Initiation fee and monthly dues are payable at the time of application. The monthly dues may be prorated at the time of the application. Monthly membership is from the first day of the current month to the last day of that month.

Membership in the club is not transferable or assignable to other individuals.

Resignation from membership must be done in writing and received by the club no less than 30 day prior to the end of the month. Resignation letters received less than 30 days prior to the end of the month, the member will be billed for dues 30 days from the date of their resignation letter.

Prior members that have left the club in good standing may rejoin the club by paying 50% of the initiation fee and the current months dues, providing their membership has not lapsed more than 3 months. Prior members that have let their membership lapse more than 3 months will be considered new members and will need to reapply for membership.

Monthly Dues

All members are subject to monthly dues. Dues are payable the first of the month. A \$ 15.00 late fee will be charged to members who do not pay their dues by the 10th of the month.

Dues are payable by credit card or Bank Draft.

Members who fail to pay their monthly dues by the 10th of the month will not be permitted to play at the club as a member or guest until the dues are paid in full with the late fee.

Members who fail to pay their dues by the end of the month will be dropped from membership.

Charges for leagues, indoor court time, and any other charges other than dues will be charged as received by the club.

Charge members will be charged \$5.00 for rejected charges that cannot be processed within 7 days of the initial charge. Members will be charged \$20.00 for any returned checks.

Guest Policy

All guests must be registered by their host member prior to using any club facilities. Guest registration for the use of the club facility is at the main reservation desk in the club house. Guest fees not paid at time of play will be charged to the host member's account in accordance with the prevailing guest fee rates.

- Indoor guest policy and rates apply to indoor courts only.
- Outdoor Guest policy and rates apply to outdoor courts only. Non member guests that return to the club within 60 days of their first visit will incur a returning guest fee of \$20 each time the guest plays as a guest until 60 days lapses from their last visit. After the 60 lapses the non member guest fee for that particular guest will return to the standard guest fee. All guest fees will be charged to the sponsoring members account and are due prior to play.
- Members with out of town guests may have their guests accompany them more than once every 60 days with prior approval from the club.

A member may be accompanied by no more than three (3) guests at any time. Guests playing tennis must play with their host member.

Non members who sub for members on indoor leagues must pay the prevailing guest fees or non-member rates as they apply.

CITC League Policy

Queen City and Interclub are club member only leagues.

USTA leagues formed at the club, may have up to 5 non-members on a team. Non-member rate to play on a USTA CITC league is \$60 per league/team. Non-member fees not paid by the first week of the season will be charged to the captain's member-account.

Captains of CITC USTA leagues with non-members will need to turn in the non-member player participation forms prior to having courts assigned for their leagues. Non-member player participation forms are available at the front desk.

Captains are responsible to ensure all non-member fees are paid prior to the start of the season. Any unpaid non-member fees will be bill to the captain's member account after the first week of the season.

Tennis Rules

All members must check in at the front desk for court assignment during normal club hours.

Normal starting time for outdoor play is 8:00 am

Play on the outdoor tennis courts is limited to 1.5 hours for singles play and 2 hours for doubles play. Play may continue as long as no one is waiting for the court.

No more than 4 people may play on a court at any time.

Outdoor and indoor court time may be reserved no earlier than 3 days in advance. Court assignment may be altered at the front desk to enable best utilization of the tennis courts. Court reservations are taken beginning at 8:30am Monday to Saturday, and 10:00am Sunday. Court reservations CANNOT be made through voicemail.

Indoor Court Cancellation Policy requires that the member notify the club of such cancellation no less than 4 hours prior to the designated time. Failure to comply with the cancellation policy will result in the member being charged at the applicable rate in the case of reserving indoor courts.

Lesson/Clinic Cancellation policy requires that the member notify the club of such cancellation no less than 24 hours prior to the designated time. Failure to comply with the cancellation policy will result in the member being charged at the applicable rate of the les-son/clinic missed.

Members are obligated to be present 5 minutes prior to the reserved court time. The reserved court may be given away to a waiting member 10 minutes after the designated reserved time.

Smoking or eating is not permitted on the courts at any time. Container drinks are permitted only on the outdoor courts. No open container drinks are permitted on the indoor courts.

Members and guests must wear appropriate tennis clothing and non-marking tennis shoes when on the tennis courts.

Miscellaneous

No pets are permitted on club grounds unless approved in advance by Club Management.

Lockers are provided for members use. The club is not responsible for any loss of items left in the lockers. The club may charge a rental fee if lockers are going to be used over an extended period of time.

Beer and wine are for sale to adult club members and their guests only. Such beverages must be consumed on club grounds. The club reserves the right to refuse sale of such beverages to any person for any reason, as determined in the sole discretion of the dispensing personnel. Only drinks purchased at the club may be consumed on the club premises. No alcoholic beverages may be kept in club lockers or brought onto club property. Random inspections are performed by ALE agents. There is a very stiff fine for both the viola-tor and the club owner.

Members who are intoxicated or under the influence of other substances will be asked to leave the premises.

Daily closing time of the club facility is based upon club activity. Hours may be changed from time to time without prior notice.

Profanity or rude gestures are not permitted on club grounds. Repeated offences will be grounds for forfeiture of membership. This rule also applies to members participating in leagues that play at offsite facilities.

Smoking is limited to outdoors and only in designated areas on the property.

Participation of all club league activities will be for the benefit of club members. At times, participation may include non-members. This will be decided at the sole discretion of the club owner. Non-member rates will apply.

Pricing of indoor leagues and normal indoor court use is based on court time, and billed in 30 min increments. Members who request to warm up prior to league time or members who continue to play after the normal league time will be charged for the extra court time at the prevailing rates.

Hand and bath towels are provided by the club. Towels that are not returned will be charged to the member.

Members are requested to turn off the outdoor lights at the end of play, if they are the last ones on the outdoor courts in the evening. Outdoor court lights are controlled by automatic timers and the lights will shut off at 10: 00 pm every evening. Contact the front desk if you need the lights on for a longer period. Court lights for courts 16, 7, 8, 9, and 10 may be turned off during the weekend for club security. Please contact the club if you plan to use any of these courts.

Members participating in club leagues must find a substitute player when they cannot play. Please contact the club for emergency only.

Disclaimer of Liability

All persons using the club facilities do so at their own risk. The club shall not be responsible for any accident or personal injury or loss of or damage to personal property.

Members agree to indemnify and hold the club harmless from and against any claims, damages, liabilities, and cost arising out of or related to any damage to or loss of club property, other personal property, or personal injury caused by such member, members, of their family or their guest, as well as for any damage to or loss of personal property or personal injury to such member, any member of their family, or their guest.

Members are responsible for any damages to the club property or club equipment that is caused by the member, family member, or guest.
